All youth competitors: AMA has approved a Scholarship to help with youth expenses for this show season. Both shows will have \$500 available to cover class costs, with that I am also reducing youth class fees to further assist the youth riders.

**Please note I will do the calculations for the youth in the office once entries are in.**

I do have access to cattle, but I need to know how many to reserve. Note I have added steer daubing and if time permits the donkeys can have a “fun” go at daubing. ## Grounds:

- Facility has water & power hook-ups for 25 rigs. Dry camping and trailer parking. Some of the hook-ups have room for mule camping, but these are limited! Dogs must be on a leash!!! There are outhouses available. Please do not "roam" the property, we have a set area we are allowed to be in!!!
- Thursday arrivals ok, please let me know arrival time so I can get you in your spot.
- Stalls are in a row covered, water and hoses provided, please bring your own bucket and shavings.

Stabling Price ***per night:*** Covered Stall \$25 Uncovered \$20

## General Information:

1. Complete one entry form per animal or team and for different rider on the same animal. Please fill out form completely. No forms will be accepted without AMA numbers, owner & exhibitor.
2. Cattle classes will have a 1 time cattle charge of \$35 per animal.
3. Entries preferred 1 week before show. Entries will be accepted at the show. No late fees.
4. All handlers, riding or leading, must sign liability waiver.
5. **NO DOGS OFF LEASH ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.**
6. Make checks payable to Jessica Bishop or Gold Country Mule and Donkey Show, GCMDS.
7. Pricing
  - \$30 per class, includes AMA fees. **(\$30 per class, double points, double judged, absolutely no single judging!!!)**
  - Discount of 10% on class total after 8 classes are entered per exhibitor/handler (more than one animal can add to the total class count for discount).

## General Class Information:

- AMA rules apply to all AMA approved classes.
- Judges decisions are final
- Be ready at the gate for your class. If you have a conflict please notify the gate crew.
- All ties will be broken. AMA point schedule will be used to calculate points.
- **All classes Friday will be one go for double points.**

**Winners Drawing. All first place wins get a ticket for the drawing, item to be determined by show management.**

**All first place class winners will receive a “ticket” for the awards table, you may combine tickets for higher value items. No ribbons available at this time.**
