- 2. Cattle classes will have a 1-time cattle charge of \$35 per animal. Each go will be charged a class fee.
- 3. Entries preferred 1 week before show. Entries will be accepted at the show. No late fees.
- 4. All handlers, riding or leading, must sign a liability waiver.
- 5. NO DOGS OFF LEASH ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- 6. Make checks payable to Jessica Bishop or Gold Country Mule and Donkey Show or GCMDS.
- 7. Pricing
 - \$40 per class, includes AMA fees. (\$40 per class, double points, double judged, <u>absolutely no</u> single judging!!!)
 - Discount of 10% on class total after 6 classes are entered per owner/exhibitor (more than one animal can add to the total class count for discount).
